Taking away my sin
John 1:29 "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world
Psalm 103:12 Bless the LORD, O my soul, for removing our transgressions from us, as far as the east is from the west

Forgiving ALL my iniquity
Psalm 103:3 Bless the LORD, O my soul, who forgives all your iniquity,

Being pierced and crushed for my sin
Isaiah 53:5 He was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities;

Delivering me from condemnation
Romans 8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.
Giving me a new heart
Ezekiel 36:26 I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you.
Saving me to the uttermost
Hebrews 7:25 He is able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God through him

Making me the righteousness of God
2 Corinthians 5:21b So that in him we might become the righteousness of God.
Giving me the gift of righteousness
Romans 5:17 Much more those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.

Crediting your righteousness to my account
Romans $4: 20$ yet, with respect to the promise of God, he did not waver in unbelief but grew strong in faith, giving glory to God, 21 and being fully assured that what God had promised, He was able also to perform. 22 Therefore IT WAS ALSO CREDITED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS. 23 Now not for his sake only was it written that it was credited to him, 24 but for our sake also, to whom it will be credited, as those who believe in Him who raised Jesus our Lord from the dead, 25 He who was delivered over because of our transgressions, and was raised because of our justification.
