Psalms 56:9 This I know, that God is for me.

Giving me a new heart

Ezekiel 36:26 I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you.

Crediting your righteousness to my account

Romans 4:20 yet, with respect to the promise of God, he did not waver in unbelief but grew strong in faith, giving glory to God, 21 and being fully assured that what God had promised, He was able also to perform. 22 Therefore IT WAS ALSO CREDITED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS. 23 Now not for his sake only was it written that it was credited to him, 24 but for our sake also, to whom it will be credited, as those who believe in Him who raised Jesus our Lord from the dead, 25 He who was delivered over because of our transgressions, and was raised because of our justification.

Psalms 147:6 The LORD lifts up the humble;

Psalms 145:14 The LORD upholds all who are falling and raises up all who are
bowed down.

Sacrificing your son on our behalf

Romans 8:32 He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all,
how will he not also with him graciously give us all things?

Delivering us from evil

Matthew 6:13 Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

Loving the Son

John 15:9 As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Abide in my love.

Loving us unceasingly

Lamentations 3:22 The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases; his mercies
never fail; 23 they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.

Making us whole

1 Thessalonians 5:23 Now may the God of peace himself sanctify you completely, and may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. 24 He who calls you is faithful; he will surely do it.

Anointing and Sealing me with your Spirit

Romans 8:29 Those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son.

Forgiving ALL our iniquity

Psalms 103:3 Bless the LORD, O my soul, who forgives all your iniquity,

Removing our transgressions

Psalms 103:12 Bless the LORD, O my soul, for removing our transgressions from us, as far as the east is from the west

Redeeming our life

Psalms 103:4a who redeems your life from the pit,

Crowning us with love and mercy

Psalms 103:4b who crowns you with steadfast love and mercy,

Satisfying us with good and renewing us

Psalms 103:5 who satisfies you with good so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.

Psalms 145:16 You open your hand; you satisfy the desire of every living thing.

Preserving us

Psalms 145:20 The LORD preserves all who love him,

Taking the Initiative to reveal your love to you.

1 John 4:10 This is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

Romans 5:8 but God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
