Abolishing death

2 Timothy 1:10 Our Savior Christ Jesus, who abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel,

Humbling yourself unto death

Philippians 2:8 And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

Dying for us when we were weak and ungodly

Romans 5:6 For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly.
7 For one will scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die—

Bringing us to God

1 Peter 3:18 Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the spirit,

Saving us to the uttermost

Hebrews 7:25 He is able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God through him

Justifying and saving us

Romans 5:9 Since, therefore, we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from the wrath of God.

Reconciling and saving us

Romans 5:10 If while we were enemies we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life.

Being pierced and crushed for our sin

Isaiah 53:5 He was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities;

Being made sin for me

2 Corinthians 5:21a For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin,

Taking away my sin

John 1:29 "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world

Faithfully forgiving our sin and cleansing us

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Setting me free from sin

Romans 6:22 Now that you have been set free from sin

Making me a slave of righteousness

Romans 6:18 Having been set free from sin, have become slaves of righteousness.

Giving me eternal life

John 3:36 Anyone who believes in God's Son has eternal life.

Emptying yourself and becoming a servant

Philippians 2:5 Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus,
6 Though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God
a thing to be grasped, 7 but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant,
being born in the likeness of men.

Delivering me from condemnation

Romans 8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

Making me the righteousness of God

2 Corinthians 5:21b So that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

Giving me the gift of righteousness

Romans 5:17 Much more those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift
of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.

Making me a new creature

2 Corinthians 5:17 Wherefore if any man is in Christ, he is a new creature:
the old things are passed away; behold, they are become new.

Being gentle, meek, and giving us rest

Matthew 11:29 I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

Encouraging us

Matthew 12:20 He will not crush the weakest reed or put out a flickering candle.

Holding us in your hand

John 10:28 I give them eternal life, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch
them out of my hand.

Praying for us

Hebrews 7:25b He always lives to make intercession for them.

Romans 8:34 Christ Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised
who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us.

Understanding our temptation

Hebrews 4:15 We do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin.

Extending mercy and grace

Hebrews 4:16 Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Never leaving or forsaking your children

Matthew 28:20 "I am with you always, even unto the end of the world."

Hebrews 13:5 "I will never leave you nor forsake you."

1 Corinthians 2:16 But we have the mind of Christ.

Isaiah 53:5 With his wounds we are healed.
