

As I have loved you, John 15:9

He was pierced and crushed for my sin

Isaiah 53:5 He was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities;

He heals me

Isaiah 53:5 With his wounds we are healed.

He is gentle, meek, and gives me rest

Matthew 11:29 I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

He encourages me and does not crush my spirit

Matthew 12:20 He will not crush the weakest reed or put out a flickering candle.

He came to serve

“But Jesus called them to him and said, ‘You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great ones exercise authority over them. It shall not be so among you. But whoever would be great among you must be your servant, and whoever would be first among you must be your slave, even as the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.’” Matthew 20:25–28.

He is with me always

Matthew 28:20 “I am with you always, even unto the end of the world.”

He gives me a hundredfold life now

Mark 10:29 Jesus said, “Truly, I say to you, there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or lands, for my sake and for the gospel, 30 who will not receive a hundredfold now in this time,

He seeks me when I was lost

Luke 19:10 For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.”

He models the word of God

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

John 1:14 The Word became flesh and dwelt among us

He is full of grace and truth

John 1:14 The Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

He takes away my sin

John 1:29 “Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world”

He understands my humanity

John 2:24–25 Jesus on his part did not entrust himself to them, because he knew all people and needed no one to bear witness about man, for he himself knew what was in man.

He gives me eternal life

John 3:36 Anyone who believes in God’s Son has eternal life.

He satisfies my thirst

John 4:14 Whoever drinks of the water that I will give him will never be thirsty again. The water that I will give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life.

He gives me the bread of life

John 6:48 I am the bread of life. 49 Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and they died. 50 This is the bread that comes down from heaven, so that one may eat of it and not die. 51 I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever.

He gives me living water

John 7:38 Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, 'Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.'

He gives me abundant life

John 10:10 I came that they may have life and have it abundantly.

He keeps me in His hand

John 10:28 I give them eternal life, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of my hand.

He prepares a place and is coming back for me

John 14:3 If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also.

He reveals the Father to me

John 14:9 Whoever has seen me has seen the Father.

Luke 10:22 No one knows who the Son is except the Father, or who the Father is except the Son and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him.

He sends the Helper to be with me forever

John 14:16 I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever

He makes me clean through the word

John 15:3 Already you are clean because of the word that I have spoken to you.

He loves me

John 15:9 As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Abide in my love.

He sends me the Holy Spirit

John 16:7 It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper shall not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you.

He gives me God's word

John 17:14 I have given them your word,

He reveals the Father's name and His love to me

John 17:26 I made known to them your name, and I will continue to make it known, that the love with which you have loved me may be in them, and I in them."

He died for me when I was weak and ungodly

Romans 5:6 For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. 7 For one will scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die—

He loved me while I was a sinner

Romans 5:8 God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

He justified me by His blood and saves me from the wrath of God

Romans 5:9 Since, therefore, we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from the wrath of God.

He reconciles me to God and saves me

Romans 5:10 For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life.

He gives me the gift of righteousness

Romans 5:17 Much more those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.

He baptizes me into His death that I may walk in newness of life

Romans 6:3 Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? 4 We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life.

He unites me with Him in His resurrection

Romans 6:5 For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his.

He crucifies my old self

Romans 6:6 We know that our old self was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin.

He dies for me that I might live with Him

Romans 6:8 If we have died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him.

He sets me free from sin and makes me a slave of righteousness

Romans 6:18 Having been set free from sin, have become slaves of righteousness.

He gives me the gift of eternal life

Romans 6:23 The wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord

He delivers me from condemnation

Romans 8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

He gives me the mind of Christ

1 Corinthians 2:16 But we have the mind of Christ.

He always leads me in victory

2 Corinthians 2:14 Thanks be to God, who in Christ always leads us in triumphal procession, and through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of him everywhere.

He makes me a new creature

2 Corinthians 5:17 Wherefore if any man is in Christ, he is a new creature: the old things are passed away; behold, they are become new.

He was made sin for me

2 Corinthians 5:21a For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin,

He makes me the righteousness of God

2 Corinthians 5:21b So that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

He became poor that I might be rich

2 Corinthians 8:9 For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor, so that you by his poverty might become rich.

He lives in me

Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me.

He gave himself up for me

Ephesians 5:2 Walk in love, even as Christ also loved you, and gave himself up for us,

He has washed me with the word

Ephesians 5:26 He might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word.

He emptied Himself and became a servant

Philippians 2:5-7 Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, Though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men.

He humbled Himself and died for me

Philippians 2:8 Being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

He abolished death and brought life

2 Timothy 1:10 Our Savior Christ Jesus, who abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel,

He delivers and saves me

2 Timothy 4:18 The Lord will deliver me from every evil work, and will save me unto his heavenly kingdom: to whom be the glory for ever and ever. Amen.

He saves me according to His mercy

Titus 3:4–5 When the goodness and loving kindness of God our Savior appeared, he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy,

He understands my weakness and temptation

Hebrews 4:15 We do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin.

He is near when I need Him

Hebrews 4:16 Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

He intercedes for me

Romans 8:34 Christ Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us.

Hebrews 7:25 Consequently, he is able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God through him, since he always lives to make intercession for them.

He cleanses me from sin

Hebrews 9:14 How much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without blemish to God, purify our conscience from dead works to serve the living God.

He never leaves me alone

Hebrews 13:5 “I will never leave you nor forsake you.”

He is my helper

Hebrews 13:6 “The Lord is my helper; I will not fear; what can man do to me?”

He never changes

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.

He forgives my sin

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

He destroyed the works of the devil

1 John 3:8 Son of God appeared .. that He might destroy the works of the devil.

He laid his life down for me

1 John 3:16 By this we know love, that he laid down his life for us,

He gives me grace, mercy, and peace

2 John 3 Grace, mercy, and peace will be with us, from God the Father and from Jesus Christ the Father’s Son, in truth and love.

He loves us by freeing us from our sins and making us a kingdom and priests
Revelations 1:5-6 Jesus Christ the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead, and the ruler of kings on earth. To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood and made us a kingdom, priests to his God and Father, to him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

He is committed to marrying me
Revelation 19:7 Let us rejoice and exult and give him the glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and his Bride has made herself ready;

He has called and chosen me
Revelation 17:14 "They will make war on the Lamb, and the Lamb will conquer them, for he is Lord of lords and King of kings, and those with him are called and chosen and faithful."

He has bought me
1 Corinthians 6:20 "You were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.
1 Corinthians 7:23 "You were bought with a price; do not become bondservants of men.
