Psalms 31:24 Be strong, and let your heart take courage, All you who hope in the LORD.

Psalms 33:18 Behold, the eye of the LORD is on those who fear Him, On those who hope for His lovingkindness,

Psalms 38:15 For I hope in Thee, O LORD; Thou wilt answer, O Lord my God.

Psalms 42:11 Why are you in despair, O my soul? And why have you become disturbed within me? Hope in God, for I shall yet praise Him, The help of my countenance, and my God.

Psalms 71:5 For Thou art my hope; O Lord GOD, Thou art my confidence from my youth.

Psalms 71:14 But as for me, I will hope continually, And will praise Thee yet more and more.

Psalms 146:5 How blessed is he whose help is the God of Jacob, Whose hope is in the LORD his God;

Proverbs 13:12 Hope deferred makes the heart sick, But desire fulfilled is a tree of life.

Lamentations 3:21 This I recall to my mind, Therefore I have hope. 22 The LORD'S lovingkindnesses indeed never cease, For His compassions never fail. 23 They are new every morning; Great is Thy faithfulness. 24 "The LORD is my portion," says my soul, "Therefore I have hope in Him." 25 The LORD is good to those who wait for Him, To the person who seeks Him.

Romans 4:18 In hope against hope he believed, in order that he might become a father of many nations, according to that which had been spoken, "SO SHALL YOUR DESCENDANTS BE."

Romans 8:24 For in hope we have been saved, but hope that is seen is not hope; for why does one also hope for what he sees? 25 But if we hope for what we do not see, with perseverance we wait eagerly for it.

Romans 15:4 Whatever was written in earlier times was written for our instruction, that through perseverance and the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.

Romans 15:13 Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

1 Corinthians 13:13 Three things will last forever—faith, hope, and love—and the greatest of these is love.

Hebrews 11:1 Faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.
