Inseparably Loved by God

“I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.” (Romans 8:38–39)

Sanctified – Saints

“To the church of God that is in Corinth, to those who are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints together with all those who in every place call upon the name of our Lord Jesus Christ,” (1 Corinthians 1:2)

Free from Condemnation

“There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.”
(Romans 8:1)

The Aroma of Christ

“Thanks be to God, who in Christ always leads us in triumphal procession, and through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of him everywhere.”
(2 Corinthians 2:14)

I Have the Mind of Christ

“We have the mind of Christ.” (2 Corinthians 2:16)

A New Creature

“Wherefore if any man is in Christ, he is a new creature: the old things are passed away; behold, they are become new.” (2 Corinthians 5:17)

Righteous

“In him we might become the righteousness of God.” (2 Corinthians 5:21)

Rich

“You know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor, so that you by his poverty might become rich.” (2 Cor. 8:9)

Crucified and Alive

“I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me.” (Galatians 2:20)

Called

“God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.” (1 Corinthians 1:9)

Alive, Raised Up, and Seated with Christ

“God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ— by grace you have been saved— and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,” (Ephesians 2:5–6)

Chosen, Holy, and Beloved

”Put on then, as God’s chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience,” (Colossians 3:12)

God’s child now

“Beloved, we are God’s children now,” (1 John 3:2)

Forgiven

“Your sins are forgiven for his name’s sake.” (1 John 2:12)

Called, Beloved, Kept

“To those who are called, beloved in God the Father and kept for Jesus Christ:” (Jude 1)

Anointed

“You have been anointed by the Holy One, and you all have knowledge.” (1 John 2:20)

God’s People, Who have Received Mercy

“Once you were not a people, but now you are God’s people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.” (1 Peter 2:10)

A Chosen Race, A Royal Priesthood, A Holy Nation, A People for His own Possession
“But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.” (1 Peter 2:9)

Loved, Freed from our sins, Made a Kingdom and Priests
“To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood and made us a kingdom, priests to his God and Father, to him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.” (Revelation 1:5b–6)
