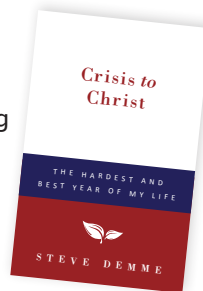

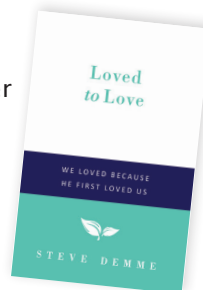
KNOWING GOD'S LOVE, BECOMING ROOTED AND GROUNDED IN GRACE

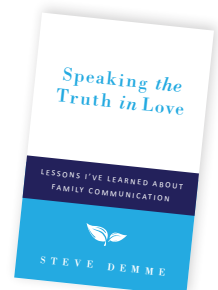
LOVED TO LOVE, WE LOVE BECAUSE HE FIRST LOVED US

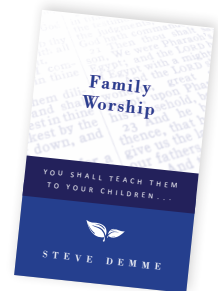
HYMNS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP
