

Successful Family Communication

Introduction: Family Board meetings, Chair Chats, Biblical Principles

- 1 Recognize the power of the tongue to build up or hurt
- "Death and life are in the power of the tongue" (Proverbs 18:21)
- "A gentle tongue is a tree of life, but perverseness in it breaks the spirit." (Proverbs 15:4)
- 2 Our speech reflects our heart values.
- "Out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks." (Matthew 12:34)
- "Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart Be acceptable in thy sight" (Psalm 19:14)
- 3 Cultivate a Quiet Spirit and Heart

Each person, "rooted and grounded" in the love of God. (Ephesians 3:17)

- 4 Esteem Others Highly and Thinking Biblically
- "In humility count others more significant than yourselves." (Philippians 2:3)
- 5 Tone is a reflection of the spirit. Respond thoughtfully instead of reacting emotionally.
- "A bruised reed He will not break, and a smoldering wick He will not guench." (Matthew 12:20)
- 6 Primary Objective is to Hear. Mutual Respect for Different Views.

Two way communication is not to convince others what you think, but understand what they think.

- 7 Encouragement for the Speaker. The Pen.
- Express clearly what you are thinking and feeling. Represent yourself with "I" expressions. Be faithful to what you know and have experienced. "Hi, my name is Steve." (Think AA)
- 8 Listeners, Quick to Hear and Slow to Speak. Explore key words.

Ask questions for clarification. Restate or rephrase; Is this what I hear you saying?

- 9 Transformed. When a speaker tells their story to an empathetic listener, greater sense of emotional and relational connection, decreased anxiety. Anatomy of the Soul, Curt Thompson
- 10 For Couples, Practice and Develop Your skills. Las Vegas. Guard what has been shared. Set time if possible. Introverts need time to process and plan what to say.
- 11 Children, Provide time to rebuild trust.

Expect someone to test safety with a potential hand grenade.







