“I am my beloved’s, and His desire is for me.” (Song of Songs 7:10)

“I am my Beloved’s and my Beloved is mine.” (Song of Songs 6:3)

“He brought me to the banqueting house, and His banner over me was love.”  
(Song of Songs 2:4)

“The LORD appeared to him from far away. I have loved you with an everlasting love;  
therefore I have continued My faithfulness to you.” (Jeremiah 31:3)

“This I call to mind, and therefore I have hope: The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases;  
His mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness.

“The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.” (2 Corinthians 13:14)

“God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ— by grace you have been saved— and raised us up with Him and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, so that in the coming ages He might show the immeasurable riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.” (Ephesians 2:4–9)

“According to the riches of His glory He may grant you to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith—that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.” (Ephesians 3:16–19)

“Walk in love, even as Christ also loved you, and gave Himself up for us.” (Ephesians 5:2)

“God our Father, Who loved us and gave us eternal comfort and good hope through grace.” (2 Thessalonians 2:16)

“When the goodness and loving kindness of God our Savior appeared, He saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to His own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit, Whom He poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that being justified by His grace we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.” (Titus 3:4–7)
