“You shall also make a basin of bronze, with its stand of bronze, for washing. You shall put it between the tent of meeting and the altar, and you shall put water in it, with which Aaron and his sons shall wash their hands and their feet. When they go into the tent of meeting, or when they come near the altar to minister, to burn a food offering to Jehovah. They shall wash their hands and their feet, so that they may not die. It shall be a statute forever to them, even to him and to his offspring throughout their generations.” (Exodus 30:18–21)

Twice each Day

“This is what you shall offer on the altar: two one year old lambs each day, continually. The one lamb you shall offer in the morning and the other lamb you shall offer at twilight. It shall be a continual burnt offering throughout your generations at the doorway of the tent of meeting before Jehovah, where I will meet with you, to speak to you there.” (Ex 29:38–39, 42)
