Giving Thanks

Ears to Hear

Twice each Day

“This is what you shall offer on the altar: two one year old lambs each day, continually. The one lamb you shall offer in the morning and the other lamb you shall offer at twilight. It shall be a continual burnt offering throughout your generations at the doorway of the tent of meeting before Jehovah, where I will meet with you, to speak to you there.” (Ex 29:38–39, 42)

Blood

It shall be a statute forever to them, even to him and to his offspring throughout their generations.”
